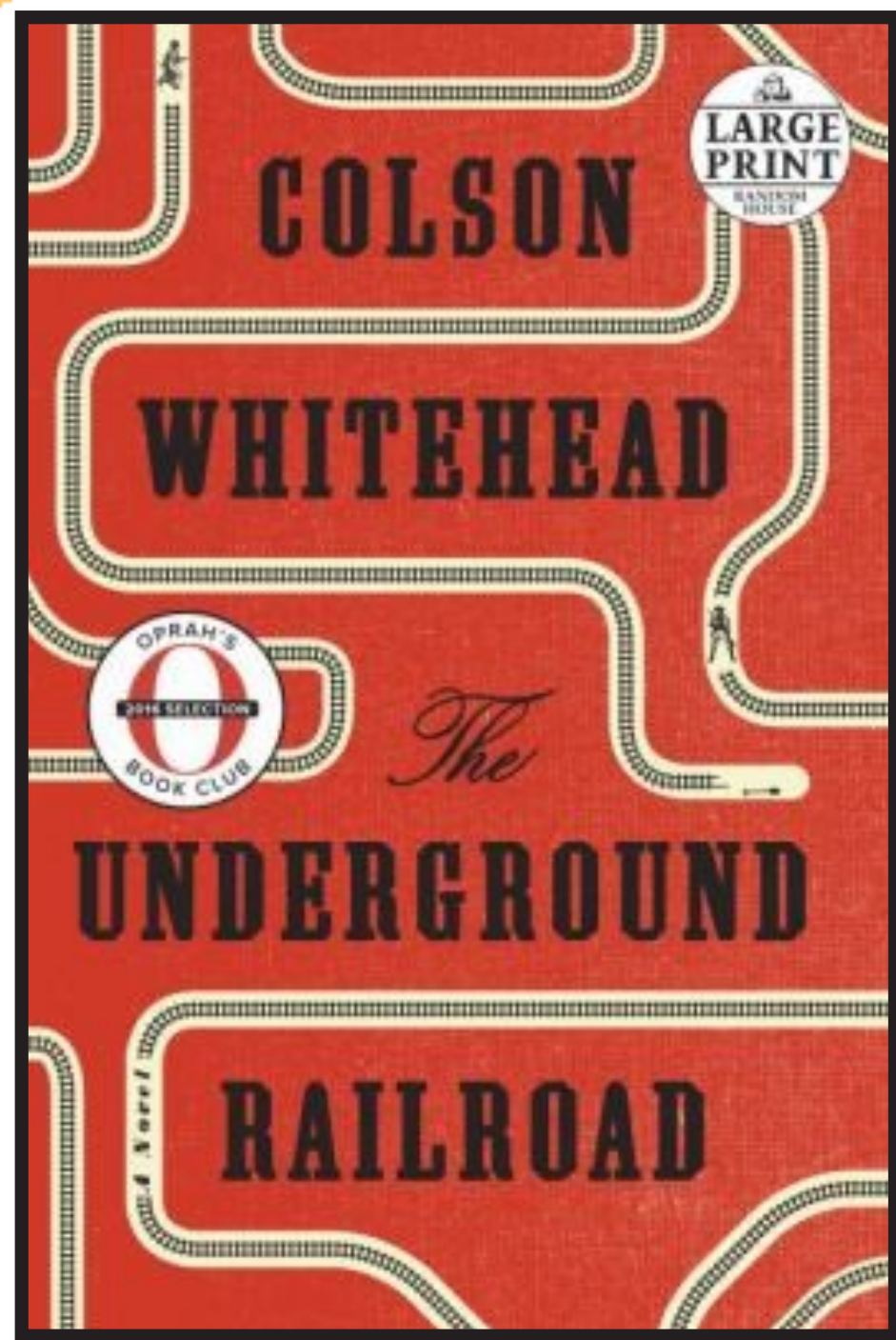


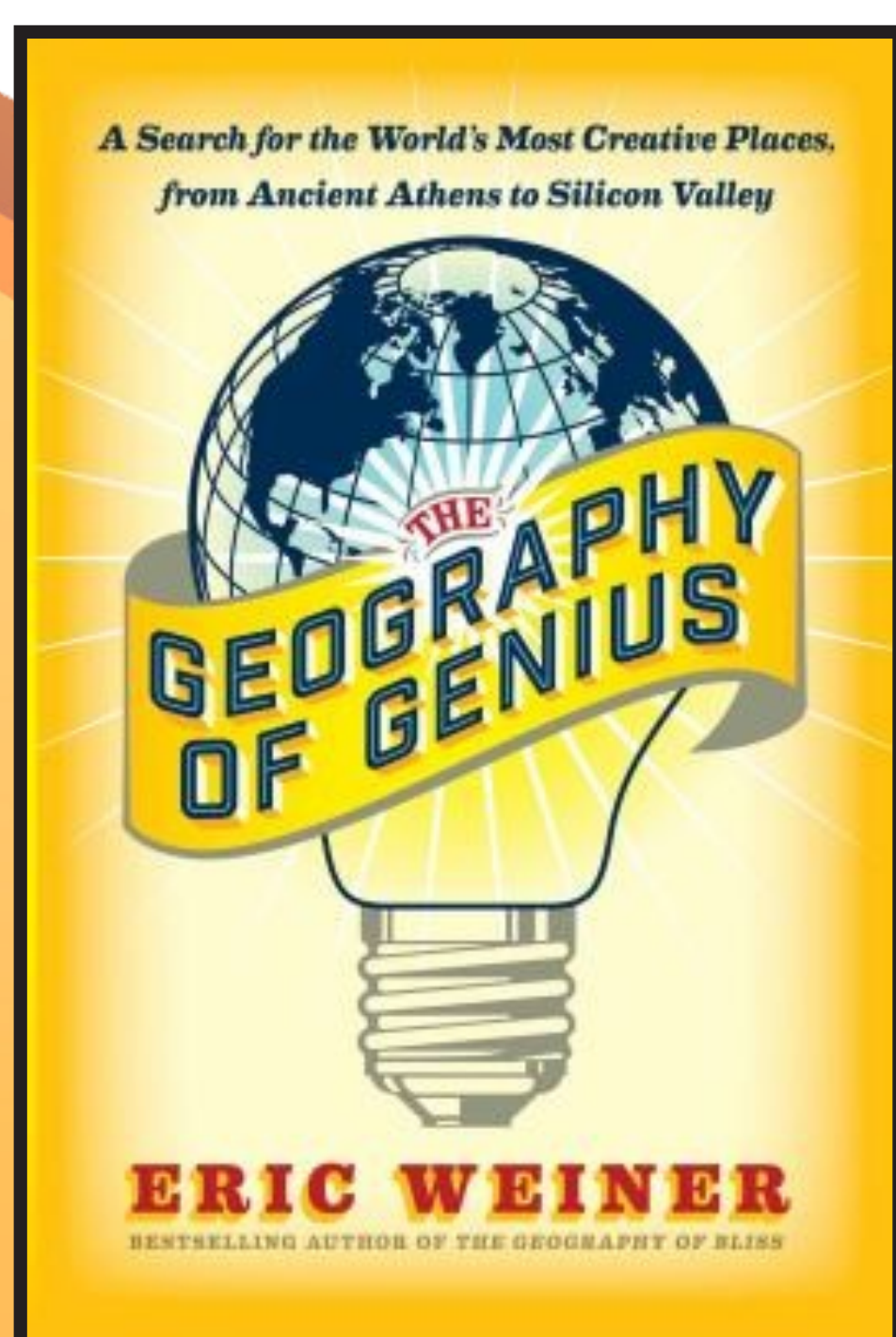
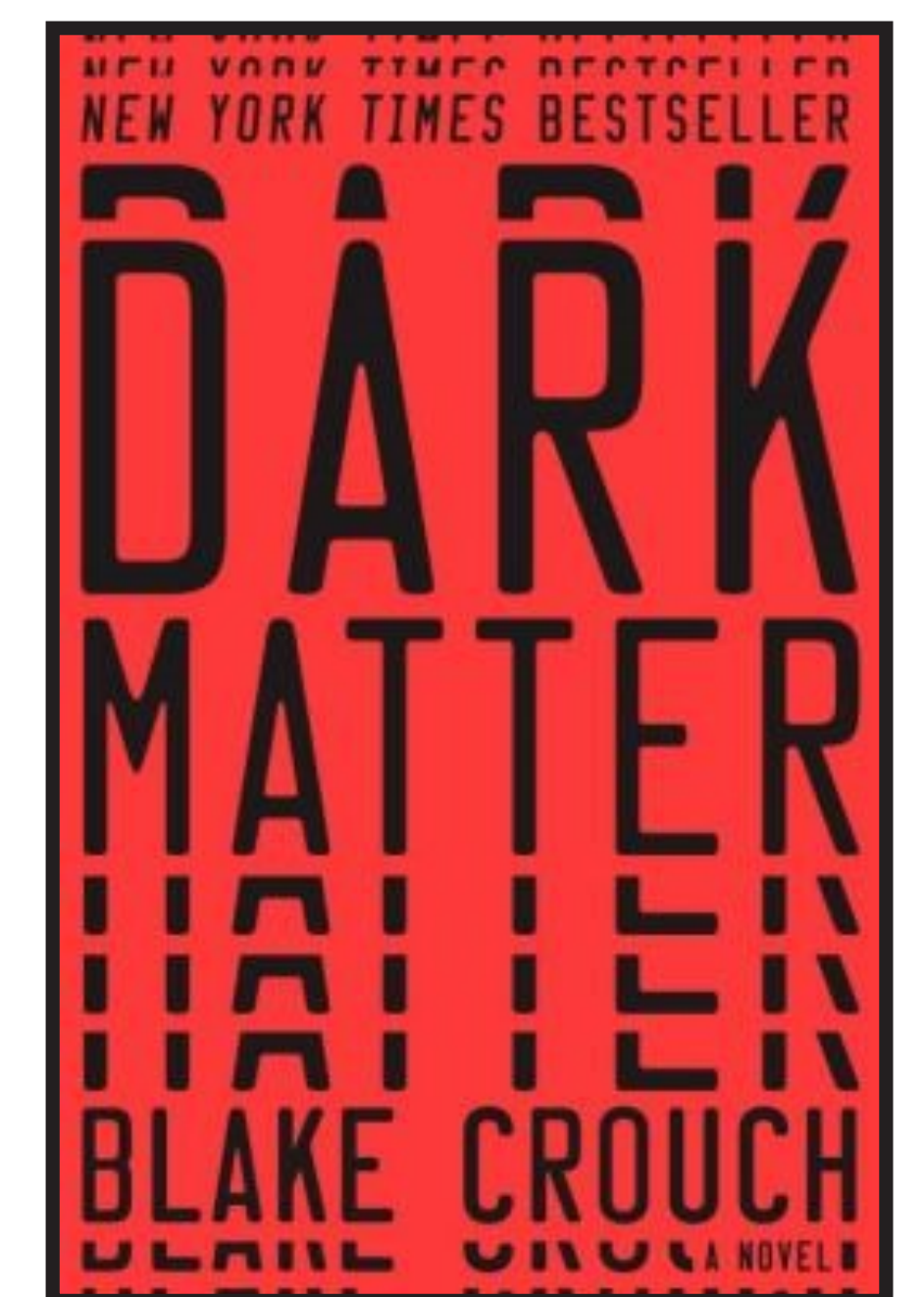
4th Tuesday Book Club @ RPL Main January - April, 2017

January 24: *The Underground Railroad*, by Colson Whitehead. This National Book Award-winning novel begins on a plantation with a slave seeking freedom, traveling aboard a secret network of tracks & tunnels, encountering different worlds in a harrowing odyssey through time and space.

February 28: *Dark Matter*, by Blake Crouch. In this thriller, Jason Dessen is a quantum physicist at a college, content with his life until he's abducted into a world where his many-worlds theory leads to mind-bending realities—where he never married and never had a son.



March 28: *The Geography of Genius: A Search for the World's Most Creative Places from Ancient Athens to Silicon Valley*, by Eric Weiner. This new book by an NPR correspondent and columnist for BBC Travel is a romp through history: traveler's diary, comic essay, and intellectual odyssey.

April 25: *The Perfect Horse: The Daring U.S. Mission to Rescue the Priceless Stallions Kidnapped by the Nazis*, by Elizabeth Letts. Hitler plans to breed an equine master race from purebreds stockpiled from other countries. General Patton authorizes a rescue operation to save the horses.
